No team will be permitted to compete without first submitting all documentation (properly completed affidavit, boundary map, residency documentation, and any necessary waivers) for review and approval by the Tournament Director. Please see District Administrator immediately if you are unclear on any matters relating to the required documentation.

Pennsylvania District 09 and Yough Little League believe strongly that all games are to be decided on the field by the players' according to the Little League Official Regulations and Playing Rules. In particular; rule XIV(a) –Field Decorum will be strictly enforced:

(a) The actions of players, managers, coaches, umpires, and league officials must be above reproach. Any player, manager, coach, umpire, or league official who is involved in a verbal or physical altercation, or an incident of unsportsmanlike conduct at the game site or any other Little League activity is subject to disciplinary actions by the local league board or directors (or by the district, if the Big League is administered as a district operation).

Any unsportsmanlike actions by players, manager, coaches, or fans from the opposing team to disrupt the play of any player, especially the pitcher, will be dealt with immediately. Pennsylvania District 09 and Yough Little League expect the manager and coaches to control their fans.

REGISTRATION

Registration for the Pennsylvania State Minor Divisions 9-11 Yr. Olds Tournament will be held on Friday, July 27, at 11 A.M. at the South Huntington Township Complex, (125 Turkeytown Road, West Newton, Pa. 15089)

The following will be part of the registration process:

1. Each team will be provided with additional information regarding the tournament logistics.
2. Each team will be required to present their official tournament affidavit, complete residency verifications, boundary map, copies of birth certificates, medical release forms, and any required waivers.
3. Each team will have equipment checked.

WELCOME CEREMONY

All team will participate in the tournament welcome ceremony to take place at the Yough Little League Complex. During the welcome ceremony, each player, manager, and coach will be introduced and other important announcements may be made. The time and date of the ceremony is listed on the game schedule attached to the end of this packet.

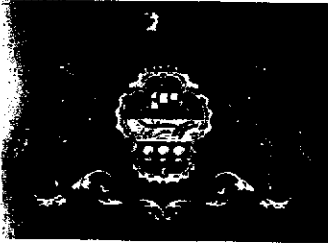
All so all Teams in this year's Tournament will receive their 2018 Pa. State Little League Pin.

TOURNAMENT ACTIVITY

There will be a players and coaches Picnic on July 27 for all teams at the South Huntington Township Complex next to the Ball field at 7:00 PM or after the last game. Final tournament activities will be announced prior to the tournament start based on the amount of teams that will be attending the tournament and the subsequent game schedule.

TEAM PRACTICES

Practice times and fields will be assigned to each team during the registration meeting. For requests for practice time beyond what is assigned during the registration meeting should be made by the team manager to the Tournament Director. The Tournament Director will promptly advise the requesting manager of the time and location available for practice.



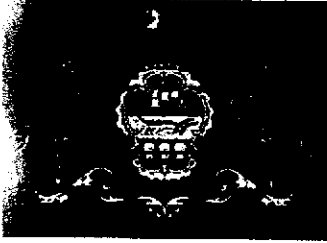
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PENNSYLVANIA STATE TOURNAMNET
RULES AND PROCEDURES HIGHLIGHTS

*"GOOD SPORTSMANSHIP IS THE HALLMARK OF ALL SUCCESSFUL
LITTLE LEAGUE TOURNAMENTS"*

1. The Tournament Rules and Regulations as published by Little League Softball shall be binding, abided by, and strictly enforced.
2. All teams will submit their **eligibility affidavits** to the tournament Director prior to each game. These affidavits must be verified **immediately** (and signed) after each game and returned to the respective teams.
3. Each manger must have, in his or her possessions, a **medical release** signed by the parent/legal guardian for each player listed on the eligibility affidavits.
4. Players, managers, and coaches that become involved in **any misconduct**, on or off the field, or at their lodging, may be dismissed from the tournament. The activity and person will be reported to the Little League Headquarters Tournament Committee, the parent league district administrator and the league president.
5. The team manager is responsible for **uniforms and equipment**. All players must be in uniform, with the Little League approved patch.
6. Only managers, coaches, and players listed on the official tournament eligibility affidavit are permitted in the dugout or playing field.
7. All **batting helmets** must meet NOCSAE approval with the warning labels.
8. **Catchers** must wear a mask with approved helmet [skullcap type is not permitted] and throat guard.
9. Shoes with **metal cleats or spikes** shall not be worn by managers, coaches, players, or umpires.



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10. No jewelry will be allowed on the playing field regardless of the material. This includes earrings, necklaces, rings, and watches. **Medical alert item ARE PERMITTED.**
11. South Huntington Township Complex is a Tobacco Free Facility.
12. Game balls will be provided.
13. All **pregame practices** will be assigned at registration. A 10-minute warm-up per team will be allowed on the game field prior to the start of each game. The home team will take the field first followed by the visiting team as determined by the coin flip at registration.
14. **Dugout Assignments:** Will be determined at registration based upon the coin flip.
15. **Home & Visitor Team Selection:** The game field is neutral for each game. A coin-toss will determine home/visiting teams at registration. The team that travels the longest distance will call the coin-toss.
16. After warm-ups have been completed on the game field, managers, coaches, umpires, and the game director will meet at home plate to review the ground rules and answer any pregame questions.
17. Both teams will meet at the home plate area immediately at the conclusion of the game and shake hands.
18. **Complementary refreshments** will be served to both teams after the game.
19. At the conclusion of the tournament, the winning team will be awarded a Championship Flag.

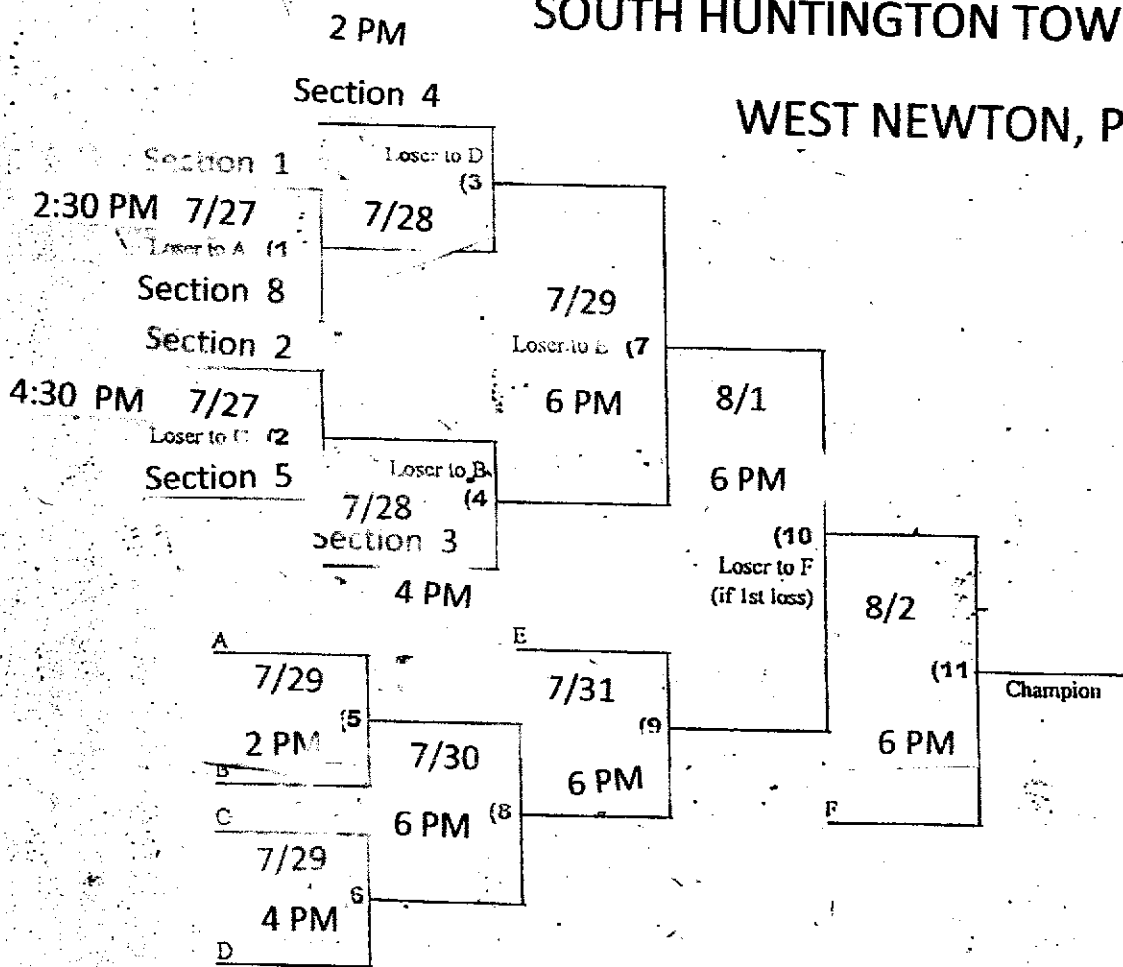
