Congratulations on winning your District and Sectional Little League Tournaments and welcome to the Pennsylvania State Little League Tournament. District 14 and Newville Little League salutes you on your accomplishment and looks forward to hosting you this week.

The tournament will begin on Wednesday, July 24th, 2024 and run through Monday, July 29th, 2024. Check-in and equipment check for teams will be held Tuesday, July 23rd, from 1:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m. at the Newville Little League Complex, 10 Little League Avenue, Newville, PA 17241. Please have all team equipment (including bats) available for inspection. There will be a mandatory meeting with tournament officials at 3:00 p.m. for all managers and coaches to discuss tournament procedures, practice and batting cage scheduling, and to answer any questions. The meeting will be held at the Newville American Legion Post 421, located next to the Newville Little League complex.

Newville Little League will be hosting a pre-tournament picnic/carnival on Tuesday, July 23rd at 5:00 pm at Newville Little League Complex, 10 Little League Avenue, Newville, PA 17241. This is mandatory and free of charge for all players, managers and coaches. Guests are also invited to attend at a cost of \$20.00 for adults and \$15.00 for children ages 12 and under. A meal will be served, and various carnival games and activities will be provided for players and siblings. Please bring lawn chairs as seating will be somewhat limited. Teams will be recognized at this time. Please submit dinner reservations as soon as possible.

We will need a team photo with your Sectional Championship banner, along with your players' names and jersey numbers for the tournament program, as well as names of managers, coaches, league presidents and district administrators. Once your team has won the Sectional Tournament, please contact **Bryan Henry**. Text or call 717-372-3811 or email at bkhenry@me.com to inform the tournament director that you have won your section tournament and will be participating in the state tournament.

Go to the tournament website home page pastatournament.org and select Team Instructions from the TEAMS drop down. Register the team from the “Team Registration page” link. Fill out the information, including your players’ names and uploading a team photo.

From the Team Instructions access the “Go to the Store Page” link and purchase T-shirts and dinner tickets.

Team Arrival

Teams should arrive at the Newville Little League Complex on Tuesday, July 23rd, from 1:00 PM – 3:00 PM for check-in and equipment check. Each team will be assigned an Aunt and Uncle (host) for the tournament to answer any logistical questions you may have during your stay. A mandatory managers and coaches meeting will take place at 3:00 pm in the Newville American Legion Post 421, located across the street from the Newville Little League Complex.

A dinner/carnival will be held from 5:00 pm – 8:00 pm at the Newville Little League Complex, 10 Little League Avenue, Newville, PA 17241.

Tournament Rules

- The Pennsylvania State Tournament will be a double elimination tournament.
- Playing rules will be per Little League (Major) Division Baseball Tournament Rules. All rules will be strictly enforced by the tournament staff and umpires.
- All teams will submit their eligibility affidavits to the tournament director prior to the start of the tournament. These affidavits must be verified (and signed) immediately following each game and will be returned to each team at the end of the tournament.
- The tournament director and staff reserve the right to change game dates and starting times due to inclement weather.
- The home team for each game will be determined by the toss of a coin 60 minutes prior to game time. The team traveling the farthest will call the coin toss. The winner of the coin flip will have the choice of home/visiting team or dugout. If the team winning the coin flip chooses home or visiting team, the team losing the coin flip has the choice of dugouts. If the team winning the coin flip chooses dugout, the team losing the coin flip has the choice of home or visiting team.
- The home team for each game will have 15 minutes of fielding practice 45 minutes prior to the start time of the game. The visiting team for each game will have 15 minutes of fielding 30 minutes prior to the start time of the games. These times may be shortened in order to stay with the scheduled game times.
- The team manager is responsible for uniforms and equipment and all players must be in uniform with the Little League approved patch.
- Players, managers, and coaches that become involved in any misconduct, on or off the field, or at their lodging, may be dismissed from the tournament. The activity and person will be reported to Little League Headquarters Tournament Committee, the District 14 Administrator, and the Newville League President.
- Only managers, coaches, and players listed on the official tournament eligibility affidavit are permitted in the dugout or playing field. Under no circumstances will coaching (or assistance to coaches) be permitted from anyone outside of the dugout area during games.
- Game balls will be supplied by Newville Little League.
- Both teams will line up as directed by the tournament director when introduced and remain there for the National Anthem and Little League Pledge.
- Both teams will line up on their respective foul lines immediately at the conclusion of the game and tip hats as a show of sportsmanship and respect.
- When a team is eliminated from the tournament the eliminated team will be presented with tournament pins. This will be done with both teams immediately following the team's final game with both teams lined up on the foul lines.
- At the conclusion of the tournament, the winning team will be awarded the Pennsylvania Championship Flag. Players will receive tournament pins and championship or runners up medallions.
