TEAM REGISTRATION

All Team Managers or his/her designated representative must report to the Tamaqua Little League Complex for registration no less than 60 minutes before the team's 1st scheduled game on Day 1 of the Tournament.

TOURNAMENT RULES / PROCEDURES -MAIN POINTS

1. The Tournament Rules and Regulations as published by Little League Baseball shall be binding & strictly enforced.
2. Each manager or his/her representative must submit their eligibility affidavit, medical releases and all tournament eligibility information to the Tournament Director.
3. The team manager is responsible for having the proper uniforms and checking of equipment (equipment will NOT be checked by the Umpire-in-Chief prior to each game). Players must be in uniform with the Little League approved patch.
4. Only manager, coaches and players listed on the official tournament eligibility affidavit are permitted in dugout area.
5. Game balls will be supplied by the Host League.
6. All pregame practices can be requested from the Tournament Director in conjunction with the Host League. A short infield/outfield warm-up may be allowed if conditions permit. This warm-up may or may not be on the game field. There are 2 batting cages at the Tamaqua Little League Complex for use.
 - a.) If conditions permit (based on weather conditions, length of prior game, etc.) the practice schedule is as follows:
 1. Team on the top of the official bracket- field practice base on game time (9-920am/12-1220pm/5-520pm)
 2. Team on the bottom of the official bracket- field practice base on game time (920-940am/1220-1240pm/520-540pm)
7. **Dugout Assignment:**

The team listed on the top of the official bracket will occupy the First Base Dugout.

The team on the bottom of the official bracket will occupy the Third Base Dugout.
8. **Home Team Selection:**

The game field is neutral for each game. A coin-flip will determine home/visiting teams. The team that traveled the farthest to the host site will call the coin flip.
9. Fifteen minutes prior to the game start, managers, coaches, umpires and the game director will meet at home plate to conduct the coin-flip, review the ground rules, and answer any pregame questions.
10. Both teams will be announced and line-up as directed by the tournament director when introduced and remain there for the National Anthem and the Little League Pledge and Parents Pledge.
11. Both teams will meet at the home plate area immediately at the conclusion of the game and shake hands.
12. Each participant will be awarded a Section Pin prior to the team's 1st game. At the conclusion of the tournament, the winning team will be awarded a PA Section 6 Championship Banner, Team Trophy, and individual medals/trophies.
13. Your conduct and that of your team must be above reproach at all times. The team manager is responsible for the conduct of the fans of their respective teams.
14. Game Changer Live will NOT be permitted to be affixed to the fencing between the dugouts and backstop area.

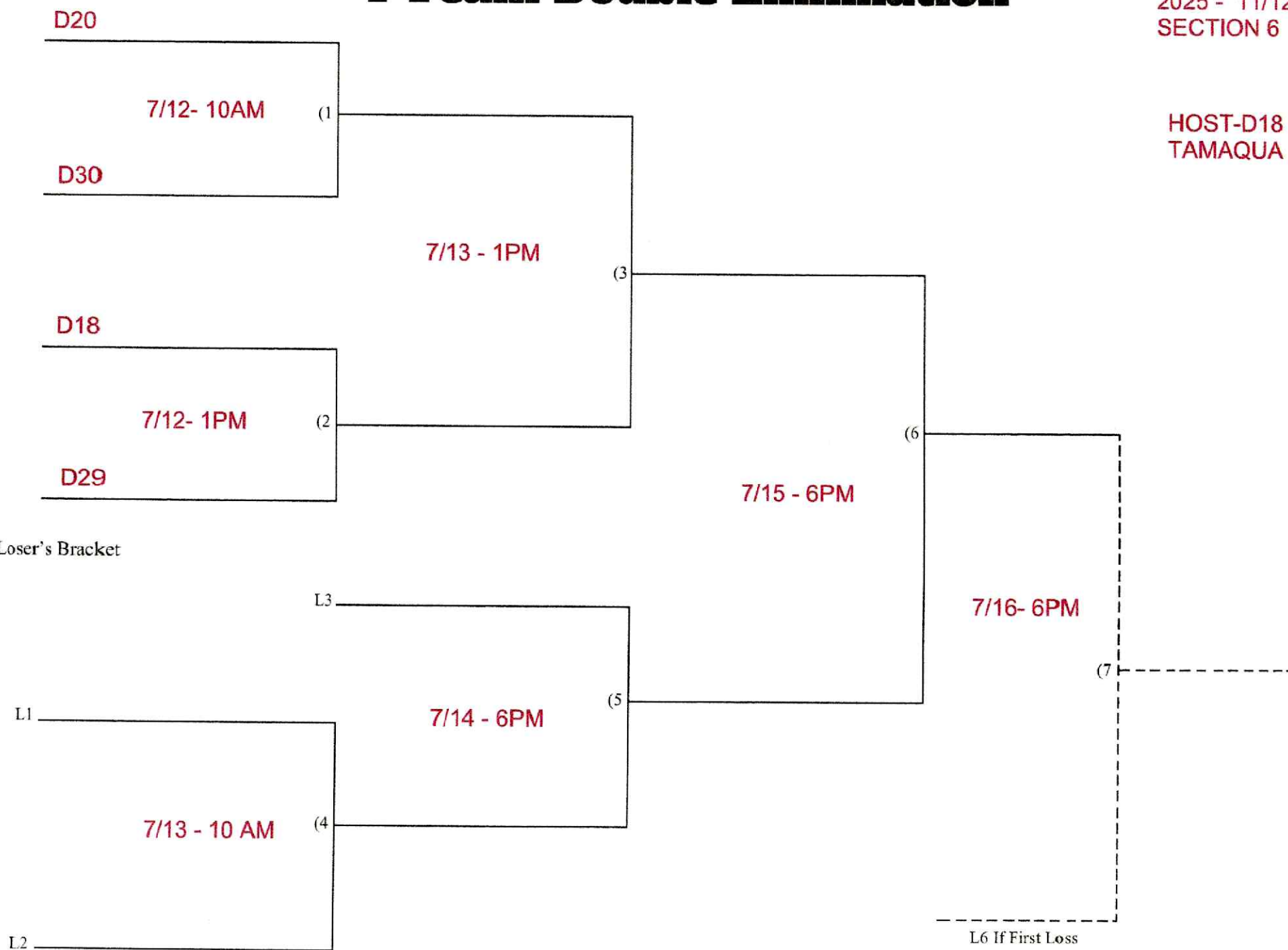
Winner's Bracket
